On Tuesday June 5, 2018 Roxana Samaniego and I (Shannon Sticken) had the pleasure of meeting with Lifetime members Ken Marsh and Marty Levy to discuss SAPA's history. With SAPA celebrating 45 years this year, we were interested in how SAPA began, how SAPA continues to evolve, and what it means to Lifetime Members to be celebrating 45 years. It started with a desire to connect and a typed letter written by Ken Marsh and Peter Berwick that was sent out to 8 psychologists in July 1972 (please see below). Ken indicated "We did not create it with 45 years in mind – it is amazing that it continues to evolve and holds space." Marty and Ken believe that inclusion, collegiality, and connection is the heart of SAPA. What began as monthly meetings in Ken's apartment has evolved into an organization embedding into the Tucson community with 165 members, including 37 Lifetime members. We continue to have monthly meetings with a hiatus in the summer and an annual holiday party in December. Both Marty and Ken indicate that they are "Awed by SAPA celebrating 45 years and believe that the power of connection will keep drawing individuals to SAPA and will keep us connected as a community." 
Beautiful Office Available for Psychologist or Therapist in NW Area

A large corner office will be available early August in a nice office suite occupied by psychologists and a therapist. The office is located in the professional complex of La Cholla Corporate Center (La Cholla between Ina and Magee, across from the Foothills Mall). The office

The suite includes a reception area, small waiting area in lobby and extra waiting room, kitchenette, 2 restrooms, and nice decor. Solid walls extend above the ceiling for improved sound control. All new carpet and paint were installed within past 3 years. Rent includes electric, water, internet, alarm system, and janitorial.
